Places to visit

Krishna Matha: Located 4.4 km from KMC Manipal, it is a significant Hindu temple dedicated to Lord Krishna, known for its cultural and architectural importance.

Malpe Beach: Situated 10.5 km from KMC Manipal, this popular tourist destination is known for its beautiful beach and a variety of activities.
