This symposium on Precursor lesions and in situ neoplasia - the Zero hour is being jointly organized by the Centre for Oncopathology (A unit of Tata Cancer Care foundation), Mumbai and the department of Histopathology, S. L. Raheja Hospital (A Fortis Associate), Mumbai.

A topic envisaged by the Late Dr. Anita Borges, this CME is being organised in her memory in the week of her birth anniversary, which is on the 19th of November.

This CME will cover precursor lesions and in situ neoplasia in detail over a vast array of systems including, but not limited to head and neck, breast, gastrointestinal tract, male and female genital tract, urinary tract, lymphoid and skin, among others.
