Attractions of Dharamshala & McLeod Ganj:

- **Tsuglagkhang Complex:** The residence and temple complex associated with Dalai Lama. It's the spiritual center of Tibetan culture in India, with monasteries, prayer wheels, and peaceful mountain views.
- **Namgyal Monastery:** A major Tibetan monastery known for Buddhist teachings, monks' debates, and meditation atmosphere.
- **Bhagsu Waterfall:** Popular short trek near McLeod Ganj with cafés and scenic views. Best visited during or just after monsoon.
- **Bhagsunag Temple:** Ancient Shiva temple near the waterfall, important for both locals and tourists.
- **Dal Lake:** A small pine-forest lake ideal for quiet walks and photography.
- **St. John in the Wilderness:** A beautiful neo-Gothic church surrounded by cedar forests.
- **Norbulingka Institute:** Excellent place to experience Tibetan art, handicrafts, and culture.
- **Triund:** The most famous trek near Dharamshala. Moderate difficulty with spectacular views of the Dhauladhar Range.
- **Naddi View Point:** Sunset point with panoramic Himalayan scenery.
- **Kareri Lake:** A beautiful alpine lake trek for adventure lovers.
