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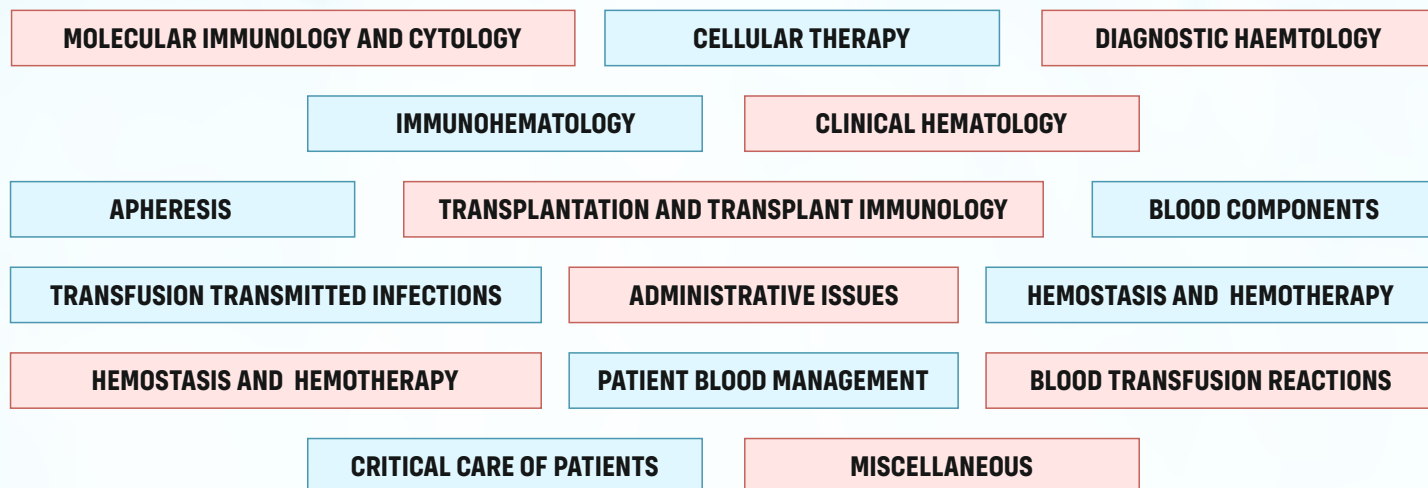
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Abstract Guidelines

Guidelines for Submission of Abstract and Presentation:

- All the papers must be submitted in English Language.
- The presenting author is required to ensure that the co-authors are aware & approve of the content. He / She should take responsibility for the accuracy of the results
- The presenting author's name should be highlighted and the presenting author's full name, institution, phone number and email address must be provided.
- Please ensure the email address of the presenting author is accurate as acceptance of abstract and further communication will be only on this address.

Iconic Spiritual Destinations in Lucknow

Shri Ram Janmabhoomi Mandir: Experience the grandeur and spiritual magnificence of the newly built Ram Mandir, a symbol of devotion and cultural pride for millions worldwide.
